## What is ParityFlex™?

ParityFlex<sup>TM</sup> is a fixed, multi-year guaranteed annuity (MYGA) – a type of insurance product – designed to help you meet your long-term retirement needs. You likely already protect your home and car through home and auto insurance, but what about protection for your savings and income? That's where ParityFlex<sup>TM</sup>, an annuity with a built-in Guaranteed Lifetime Withdrawal Benefit, comes in.

It is a simple, guaranteed way to build your retirement savings without the risk of investing in stocks, bonds, or mutual funds. And when you're ready, ParityFlex™ allows you to withdraw a portion of those savings, plus the interest you've earned on them up to that point, each year as income payments for the rest of your life with a Guaranteed Lifetime Withdrawal Benefit (GLWB) rider.¹


#### Life doesn't come with guarantees, but ParityFlex<sup>™</sup> does

With ParityFlex's GLWB, you remain in control of your investment. You can choose to begin receiving your guaranteed income when the time is right for you. And since you don't have to annuitize your contract to turn on income, you retain the flexibility to access your underlying account value if you need it.

If you're 65 today, the probability of living to a specific age or beyond





## Here's how your guaranteed income works:

- You purchase ParityFlex<sup>™</sup>, which includes a GLWB for no additional fee. The GLWB guarantees that you will receive a pre-determined amount of retirement income for life, based on your account value at the time you begin making GLWB withdrawals, as long as certain conditions are met.
- On the day you decide to activate your GLWB (your "Income Start Date"), we take your current account value
  and multiply it by a lifetime withdrawal percentage based on your then-current age to determine your annual
  withdrawal amount. This is the amount you may withdraw in any contract year after the Income Start Date
  without withdrawal charges or reducing the annual withdrawal amount in future years. Withdrawals that exceed
  this amount in any year are considered "Excess Withdrawals" and reduce future payments on a pro-rata
  (i.e., proportionate) basis. Once your GLWB is activated, your lifetime withdrawal percentage is locked in
  and will not change.

## Gain peace of mind with predictable growth and market protection

While lifetime income is the icing on top of the cake, guaranteed growth and stock market volatility protection are essential layers. They enable your money to grow at a predictable rate to help you keep up with inflation and sustain your lifestyle in retirement.

#### How it works

When you purchase a ParityFlex<sup>™</sup> contract, your interest rate is immediately locked in for a 7-year guarantee period. Your money goes to work for you right away, earning the specified rate for the length of the guarantee period, regardless of what happens to the stock market or interest rates. As long as you hold your contract for the length of the guarantee period, your principal and the interest you earn are guaranteed.

Once the 7-year period is up, you have the option to renew your contract for another 7-year term at rates that are competitive at that time. For additional options, refer to the Product Summary.


#### The power of tax-deferred growth

To help your money work harder, all your earnings in ParityFlex<sup>™</sup> grow 100% tax-deferred until you start taking withdrawals or income payments.

Tax-deferred growth offers benefits like:

- **Compounding:** The interest you earn generates additional returns, creating a compounding effect. Over time, the compounding of gains on both your initial premium and the accumulated earnings can significantly enhance your overall growth, as you can see in the chart below.
- **Timing of taxation:** Tax-deferred growth lets you control the timing of when you pay taxes. By deferring taxes until withdrawals are made, you may be in a lower tax bracket, potentially resulting in a lower overall tax liability.
- More efficient accumulation: The ability to retain all of your earnings without the impact of annual taxes allows the investment to grow more efficiently.

#### You need growth to have enough for retirement



This hypothetical chart illustrates how tax deferral would affect a \$100,000 initial premium, before any withdrawals or fees, during a 20-year period versus a similar non-tax deferred product. The chart assumes an annual interest rate of 5% and a federal income tax rate of 28%. While taxes in tax deferred investments are deferred until withdrawal, withdrawals are subject to ordinary income tax and, if made prior to age 59 ½, to a 10% IRS penalty. Taxes in a taxable investment are not deferred and are taxed currently. Consider your personal investment time horizon and income tax brackets, both current and anticipated, when making an investment decision.

## What if you need access to your money in an emergency?

Unlike some other fixed income products, ParityFlex<sup>™</sup> lets you access a portion of your investment each year (should you need it) without charge prior to annuity payments.

**During your first contract year:** The free withdrawal amount is equal to 10% of your initial purchase payment or Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) amount, if applicable.<sup>1</sup>

**After your first contract year:** You may take up to 10% of your most recent contract anniversary value, or an RMD, if greater.

**Partial or full withdrawals:** You have the flexibility, should you need it, to take more than your free withdrawal amount. If you choose to withdraw more during the 7-year guarantee period, please note that withdrawal charges and/or a market value adjustment may apply.
